I am writing to reassure you that NMI is committed in its support of your goal of earning your AMS Infant and Toddler or Early Childhood credential! We are currently enrolling for our 2021-22 courses for both our **Infant and Toddler** and **Early Childhood** Teacher Credential Programs. These programs are affiliated with the American Montessori Society (AMS) and are fully accredited by the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher Education (MACTE).

The summer phase of training for both the IT and the EC courses will begin on Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and will be done 100% online. This will be a synchronous course done through Zoom, with classes held Monday – Friday from 9 am until 5 pm. We anticipate being able to begin in-residence classes at Gordon College at some point during the seminar phases, based on CDC and Gordon College policies, along with those of our affiliate and accrediting organizations. Participants in the Early Childhood program have the option of extending their training over a two-year period, in which case the nine-month internship can be postponed until the start of the second academic year. This flexibility is an indication of NMI's support of its adult learners and their individual circumstances.
